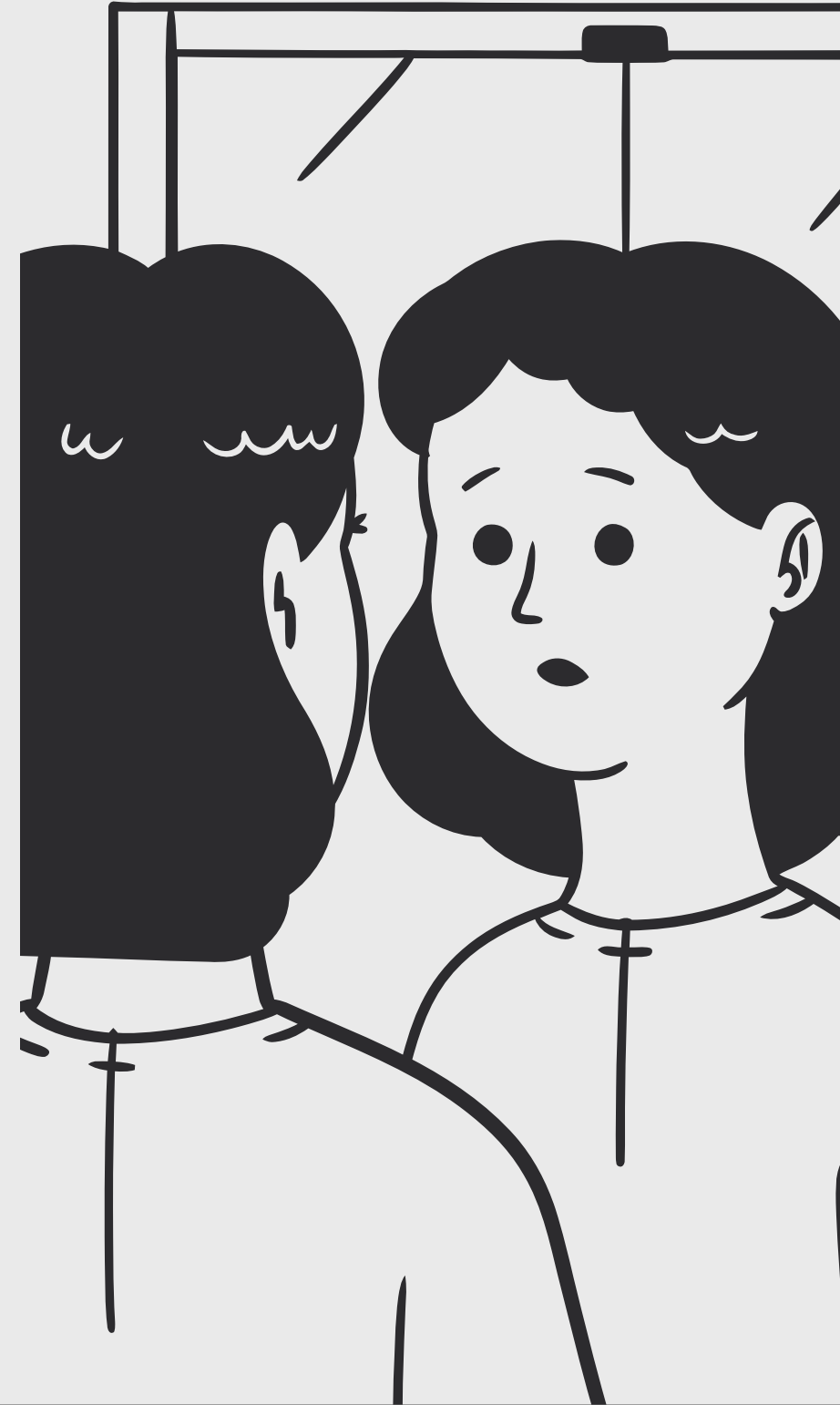
Assessments

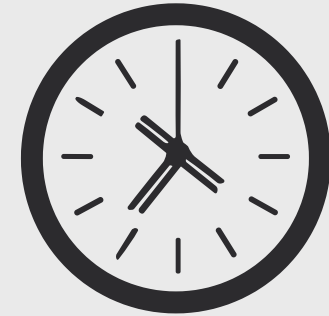
