

Bizzy | Cookie Statement

In providing and through your use of our services, products, and information (collectively referred to as the "Products") through our website, application, or any other platform (collectively referred to as the "Platform"), Bizzy Fintech BV ("we," "us," "our") will use certain cookies that are placed on the device of the user of the Platform ("you" or "your").

The Platform is operated by Bizzy Fintech BV, located at Dok-Noord 4E, PO Box 004, 9000 Ghent, Belgium, with company/VAT number (BE) 0770.493.071.

All inquiries regarding cookies, privacy, or your personal data will be directed to our central point of contact. We will strive to respond as promptly as possible.

1. General Information

This cookie statement ("Cookie Statement") explains the various types of cookies and other tracking technologies ("cookies") that we use on the Platform and how you can manage these cookies.

We adhere to a strict privacy policy and are committed to being transparent about the technologies used on our Platform. If the information collected through cookies includes personal data, the provisions of our Privacy Statement apply and complement this Cookie Statement.

2. Some Information on Cookies

A cookie is a small text file placed by a website's server in your browser or on your device's hard drive when you access or use the Platform. Cookies help distinguish you from other users of the Platform. A cookie file consists of (a) the name of the server that placed the cookie file, (b) an expiry date, and (c) a unique number code.

Cookies are stored in a separate folder for the web browser and on your device's hard disk. Refer to your device's user instructions to locate them.

"First-party cookies" are used by the visited website/platform itself. "Third-party cookies" originate from a different website/platform.

"Session cookies" disappear automatically when you end your session on our Platform, while "Persistent cookies" remain for a predetermined period.

According to legal provisions, the use of strictly necessary cookies does not require your explicit consent. However, for transparency, we inform you of this through this Cookie Statement. We request your explicit consent for other non-essential cookies (e.g., functional cookies, analytical cookies, marketing cookies) via the cookie pop-up on the Platform. Clicking an electronic button (or otherwise indicating your choice electronically) is equivalent to a written signature to confirm agreement with a legal contract. Through our cookie bar, you can accept all cookies, reject them, or accept only certain categories of cookies.

You can withdraw your consent at any time. Further in this Cookie Statement, we explain how to do this easily. Your cookie settings will be maintained during subsequent visits to our Platform unless you change them as explained herein.

3. Which Cookies Are Used on the Platform

We use different types of cookies on the Platform for the following purposes:

3.1. Strictly Necessary Cookies

These cookies are essential for browsing our Platform or providing a service specifically requested by a user. Removing these cookies is not possible, and only an information requirement applies. If you do not agree, you may not use our Platform.
