Day 1

Arrival/Dinner/Evening walk in Yerevan

Upon arrival at Zvartnots International Airport, Yerevan, you will be warmly welcomed by our representative and transferred to your hotel. Check in and enjoy an overnight stay in Yerevan.

Day 2

City Tour (Victory Park, Victory Museum, Cascade Complex, Republic square, Blue Mosque)

After breakfast at the hotel, begin your city tour with a visit to Victory Park, offering panoramic views of Yerevan. Continue with a leisurely walk through the Cascade Complex, home to the Gafesjian Center for the Arts, renowned for its impressive contemporary art collection. Later, visit the historic Blue Mosque, dating back to the 18th century. Enjoy free time for shopping at the Vernissage market.

Overnight stay at the hotel in Yerevan



Day 3

Yerevan- Tsaghkadzor – Lake Sevan – Dilijan - Yerevan

Breakfast at the hotel, later proceed to Tsaghkadzor and ride the Tsaghkadzor Ropeway for breathtaking views of snow-covered Armenia. Optional activities such as zip-lining are available for adventure enthusiasts. Continue to Lake Sevan, the largest lake in the Caucasus and one of the world’s highest freshwater lakes, where you may enjoy a scenic boat ride. Later, travel to Dilijan, often referred to as the “Armenian Switzerland” for its lush forests and pleasant climate. Take a short walk through Old Dilijan for memorable photographs before returning to Yerevan in the evening. Overnight stay at the hotel in Yerevan.

Day 4

Yerevan – Khor Virap Monastery- Khor Virap Garden - Jermuk

Today, begin the tour with a visit to Khor Virap. In the garden, enjoy a hands-on masterclass and tasting of traditional *Zhingyalov* bread, a local specialty prepared with fresh herbs and greens. Continue onward to Jermuk, renowned for its hot springs and famous mineral water. The town is celebrated for its crisp mountain air, scenic waterfall, artificial lakes, walking trails, surrounding forests, and therapeutic mineral water pools. Currently being redeveloped into a modern hub for wellness and tourism, Jermuk offers a refreshing retreat. Overnight stay at the hotel in Jermuk.

Day 5

Jermuk – Mikayelyans Farm in Gavar – Yerevan



After breakfast at the hotel, check out from your hotel in Jermuk and depart for the Gavar region. Upon arrival at Mikayelyans Farm, a family-run eco-farm, enjoy a guided tour where you'll meet local farmers and learn about traditional Armenian cheese-making, animal care, and sustainable farming practices. In the evening, return to Yerevan. Overnight stay at the hotel in Yerevan.



Day 6 **Yerevan – Arch of Charents –Garni Temple-Geghard Monastery- Symphony of Stones-Yerevan**

After breakfast, begin the day with a visit to the Arch of Charents, where sweeping views of the Ararat Valley and the iconic Mount Ararat set the tone for Armenia's deep historical and spiritual legacy. Continue to the Garni Temple and enjoy a gentle walk to the Symphony of Stones, a remarkable natural monument formed by towering basalt columns and closely tied to local folklore. Return to Yerevan for an overnight stay at the hotel.

Day 7 **Transfer to the airport**

Breakfast at the hotel. Check out from the hotel. Transfer to the airport. Departure.

Important note:

Visa fee is included we will need the below documents to process the same.

- Scanned colored copy Passport name page and address page
- Photo Bank statement (3months at list) signed and stamped
- Insurance (signed and stamped)

- Confirmed Air ticket reservation
- Scanned colored copy of available visa

Cancellation policy:

- 10% cancellation fee for cancellation from 84 to 57 days prior to arrival
- 50% cancellation fee for cancellation 56 to 31 days prior to arrival
- 80% cancellation fee for cancellation 30 to 25 days prior to arrival
- 100% Full charge for cancellation done 24 days prior to arrival and for no shows as well.

The following are the Booking Conditions, please go through the same carefully:

1. It is imperative that a code of conduct is followed by each member of the group. Instructions given by the AGAPO Trip leader must be adhered to strictly so that you do not endanger yourself and the other members of the group.
2. As accommodation is mostly on a twin-sharing basis your roommate on many occasions will be a stranger. A lot of patience, compassion and adjustment is required by each to ensure a pleasant atmosphere.
3. Harassment of the AGAPO Trip Leader in any circumstances will not be acceptable and tolerated. The AGAPO Trip Leader accompanying you on this trip is primarily a single point contact between the group and the local service provider. The AGAPO Trip Leader is NOT meant to be a guide for the group, she is a person who supervises the guide and ensures that all things are in place. AGAPO hires the guide whenever the particular tour needs the services of a guide. Sometimes, a few Wanderers are under the impression that the group is paying for the AGAPO Tour Manager to be on the trip. That is NOT true. We are entitled to send a tour leader along and her being there or not being there, do not affect/change tour cost in any way.
4. Punctuality cannot be compromised under any circumstances as even a minute's delay by even one member affects the entire group and the tour.
5. AGAPO further reserves the right to change the itinerary and hotel, if necessary, in similar category as specified at the time of booking of Tour. AGAPO further undertakes to provide all facilities and/ or inclusions committed to you at the time of booking of the Tour. Sometimes the programs in the itinerary have to be changed due to unforeseen circumstances like weather change etc. but the AGAPO Trip Leader will try and ensure that all of them are done during the tour even if in a changed order.
6. Balance payments towards the cost of the AGAPO Tour with the contact details of an emergency contact at home must reach us at least 45 days prior to the departure unless any other specific date is conveyed as last day for receiving the payment for your tour. If you fail to do so, this could result in cancellation of your seat and cancellation charges plus cost on actuals, if any, would be charged.
7. On payment of the balance amount in full you will receive your confirmation with final itinerary. This confirmation will be valid for your travel on the tour. Your Final documents will be issued, upon receiving your balance payment. It may be noted that the aforesaid payment does not include the cost of portage, tips, insurance, laundry, phone calls, food and beverages or anything not specified in the itinerary of the tour. Your final AGAPO confirmation entitles you to travel on the Tour.
8. Cancellation Policy : If circumstances make you cancel your Tour, the cancellation must be intimated to us in writing. The cancellation charges would be levied will be as per actual and policy of each program.
9. Flight cancellation or any change in that by the airline will not be covered by us or will not have any impact on the on ground services. Land package policy will be applicable at all times.
10. AGAPO reserves the right to cancel any Tour prior to the departure, without assigning any reason. In such situation we will organize the Tour on a different date and make your bookings for the same if alternate Tour date is acceptable to you. In case the alternate tour date is not acceptable to you, we will refund the entire

amount due and payable to you, however, you will not be entitled to claim any compensation. AGAPO cannot take responsibility for any cost or any fees relating to the issuance and/ or cancellation of air tickets or other arrangements.

11. AGAPO would not be held responsible for occurrence of any of the following circumstances during or before the commencement of the Tour and any extra costs occurring due to these are to be borne by you:

- a) Any act of God, like heat wave, heavy rain, floods, land slide, earthquakes, extreme bad weather, war, Visa denied, deportation etc.
- b) Any delay or cancellation of flights, ferry, trains, bus etc.
- c) medical problem, sickness, physical inability to manage with the itinerary or any other such matter. Such an inability shall not affect/ delay rest of the group on the Tour.
- d) Lost luggage, loss of personal belongings and/ or theft etc.
- e) Change in foreign exchange rates after declaration of the tour price.

12. The Booking Conditions shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of India. Any litigation arising under or concerning these Booking Conditions shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the courts of Delhi.

13. No refund for not used services on ground.

14. Refunds (if any) for amendments and/ or cancellations will be paid directly to you by AGAPO. It would take at least 30 days to process refunds.
