- Everyone has a chance to win, answers are scored on both accuracy and speed – the faster a player answers correctly, the more points they score!

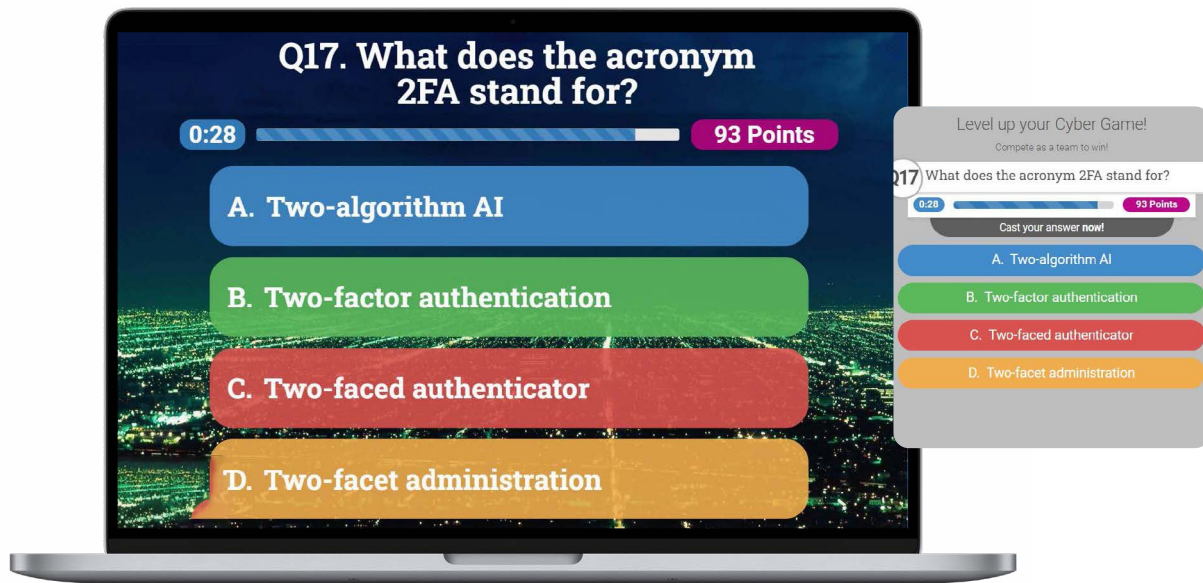

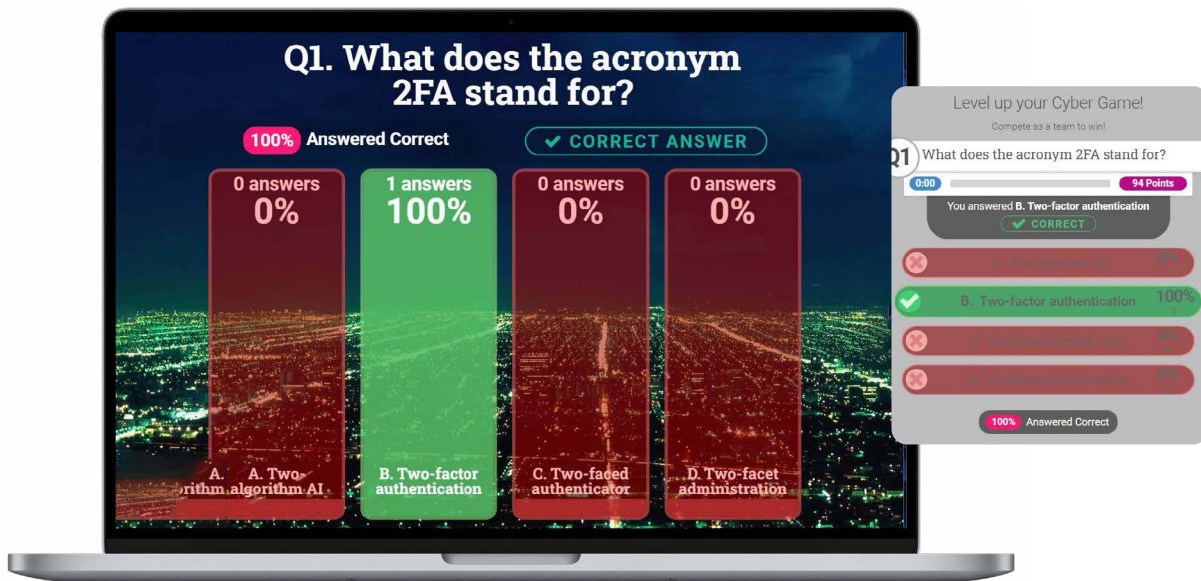
Timed Question Answering
