26 A — Needs a comma after the introductory clause: "When the west vent stuck, ...".
27 B — Missing comma after the

reporting clause: "Mr Sato said, 'keep the drone...'".

28 E — **No error**: coordinated clauses correctly punctuated.

29 A — Non-restrictive clause needs a comma after "1891": "The conservatory, which dated from 1891, glowed...".

30 E — **No error**: coordinated clauses correctly punctuated.

31 D — Shoulders **uncoil** (relax).

32 B — Music thins to a **single** thread.

33 A — Let the moment **happen**.

34 D — Reputation will **build** with honest tending.
