Thanks for taking a look at my proposal for the new School of Humanity website. Please do keep in mind that all text on the site is just placeholder.

Starting with the hero: the top section will feature the video from the current site. Which gives visitors a sense of what SoH is all about. You might notice that the navigation is down at the bottom; this gives the logo breathing room and keeps the video as a full-sized opening. Below that, you've got the headline, description, and call to action.

Next, the site establishes some social proof, creating trust and leading up to the next part of the page.

Probably the most important section on the site, explaining what School of Humanity does differently. Giving visitors a really simple overview so they know exactly what to expect.

This section is a reimplementaion of the current learner grid on the homepage, with the difference being that this sildeshow is designed to feel more personal.

I've created this visual representation of how learning works at SoH, with the puzzle pieces representing the different components connecting. This would also be a great place for micro interactions, like expanding on hover or being slightly draggable.

Framer is actually quite a versatile tool, and is very flexible. This quiz would be built entirely in Framer and helps a visitor figure out if School of Humanity is the right fit for them or their family. The quiz gives them a real result at the end, leaving a strong impression.

And finally, before the footer, here is a testimonials section. I would like to incorporate some sort of motion into this too, either through a slideshow format or scrolling animation, to keep it feeling alive rather than static.

The footer, with the most prominent element now being the new noticeboard. Currently it's promoting the open day, but could also be used to announce other key dates such as the end of term. The newsletter signup has also moved down into the footer.
