Day 1:

You will be met at the Seoul Airport and transferred to the hotel.

Later, visit the iconic **Starfield Library** located inside **COEX Mall**, followed by leisure time to explore the mall. Don't miss a photo stop at the famous **Gangnam Style Statue**.

Wrap up the day with a relaxing visit to **Han River Park**, where you can enjoy scenic views of the city, especially beautiful in the evening.

Return to the hotel.

Day 3: **Heritage, Views & K-Culture**

Continue to **Gyeongbokgung Palace**, the largest and most magnificent of Seoul's five grand palaces, where you can admire traditional Korean architecture and learn about the country's royal heritage.

Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant.

Step into modern Korean culture with an exciting K-pop dance class—an energetic and fun experience for all ages.

Later, explore **Bukchon Hanok Village**, a charming neighborhood filled with beautifully preserved hanok houses, offering a glimpse into Seoul's past.

End the day with free time at **Myeongdong**, one of the city's most vibrant shopping and street food hubs.

Return to the hotel.

Day 4: **Seoul to Busan**

Breakfast at the hotel and check out. Transfer to the station for the KTX bullet train to Busan.

On arrival, enjoy the Songdo Air Cruise Cable Car (round trip) and visit the Songdo Yonggung Suspension Bridge.

Lunch at a local restaurant.

Later, explore BIFF Square & Gukje Market, followed by the immersive Arte Museum Busan experience.

Check in to the hotel.

Overnight in Busan.

Free Time Relax and unwind with some free time. Consider indulging in a traditional Korean spa experience (Jjimjilbang - not included).

Day 5:

Busan's Scenic Coastal Attractions

Today is dedicated to exploring Busan's beautiful coastal scenery and unique attractions.

Haeundae Skywalk: Take a walk on this glass-bottomed skywalk extending over the ocean, providing thrilling views of the crashing waves below.

Blue Line Beach Train: Enjoy a colorful and scenic ride along the coast on the **Beach Train**

Lunch at a local restaurant

Haeundae Beach : Visit Busan's most famous beach & **Haeundae Yacht Tour:** Experience Busan's coastline from a different perspective with a relaxing yacht tour.

Day 6:

Busan- Gyeongju

After breakfast drive to Gyeongju, the ancient capital of the Shilla Kingdom for nearly a thousand years, is a city brimming with historical and cultural treasures, earning it the nickname "the museum without walls."

Seokguram Grotto: Visit this UNESCO World Heritage site, home to a magnificent and serene Buddha statue carved into a granite cave.

Lunch at a local restaurant

Cheomseongdae Observatory: Marvel at one of the oldest astronomical observatories in East Asia, dating back to the 7th century.

Day 7: Gyeongju- Seoul

After breakfast and hotel check-out, board the bullet train to Seoul and enjoy a comfortable journey into the vibrant capital city. Upon arrival, visit the iconic Dongdaemun Design Plaza, known for its futuristic architecture and creative spaces, followed by free time to explore the bustling Dongdaemun Market and the famous Gwangjang Market, where you can experience authentic Korean street food and local culture. Later, check in to your hotel and conclude the day with a special farewell dinner before your overnight stay in Seoul.

Day 8: Departure from South Korea

Enjoy a final breakfast at your hotel before transferring to Incheon International Airport (ICN) for your departure.

- 1 night in hotel Gyeongju similar 4 star class hotel

- Bullet train Gyeongju-Seou one-way / economy class)
- Private transportation incl. group airport transfer
- Entrances as per the program
- Meals: - 07 Breakfast and LUNCH on (DAY 2, 3, 4, 5, 6) & DINNER (DAY 1 & 7)
- Hanbok wearing activity at GYEONGBOKGUNG PALACE
- Seoul city tour
- Busan City tour

The above cost excludes:

- Tips- USD 5 per person per day (mandatory)
- 5% GST & Travel Insurance
- Personal expenses
- Other lunches or dinner not included in the program
- Drinks during meals.
- Any other services not mentioned above.
- International flights
- Drinks, extra meals, and any personal expenses.
- Optional excursions.

- TCS as applicable by the govt.
- Additional 15% TCS on travel expenditure exceeding INR 7 lakh per year per person.
- Medical emergencies.
- All transfers are group transfer together and if you arrive at a different time additional transfers can be arranged at an extra cost.
- Any cost due to any emergency or medical expenses.

Cancellation Policy:

1. Cancellation is free within 60 days prior arrival
2. 10% charge o if cancelled 59-51 days prior to arrival

3. 25 % charge if cancelled 50-45 days before arrival
4. 50 % charge if cancelled 46-34 days before arrival
5. 70 % charge if cancelled 33-20 days before arrival
6. 80 % charge if cancelled 19-16 days before arrival
7. Less than 15 days 100 % charge will apply

The following are the Booking Conditions, please go through the same carefully:

1. It is imperative that a code of conduct is followed by each member of the group. Instructions given by the AGAPO Trip leader must be adhered to strictly so that you do not endanger yourself and the other members of the group.
2. As accommodation is mostly on a twin-sharing basis your roommate on many occasions will be a stranger. A lot of patience, compassion and adjustment is required by each to ensure a pleasant atmosphere.
3. Harassment of the AGAPO Trip Leader in any circumstances will not be acceptable and tolerated. The AGAPO Trip Leader accompanying you on this trip is primarily a single point contact between the group and the local service provider. The AGAPO Trip Leader is NOT meant to be a guide for the group, she is a person who supervises the guide and ensures that all things are in place. AGAPO hires the guide whenever the particular tour needs the services of a guide. Sometimes, a few Wanderers are under the impression that the group is paying for the AGAPO Tour Manager to be on the trip. That is NOT true. We are entitled to send a tour leader along and her being there or not being there, do not affect/change tour cost in any way.
4. Punctuality cannot be compromised under any circumstances as even a minute's delay by even one member affects the entire group and the tour.
5. AGAPO further reserves the right to change the itinerary and hotel, if necessary, in similar category as specified at the time of booking of Tour. AGAPO further undertakes to provide all facilities and/ or inclusions committed to you at the time of booking of the Tour. Sometimes the programs in the itinerary have to be changed due to unforeseen circumstances like weather change etc. but the AGAPO Trip Leader will try and ensure that all of them are done during the tour even if in a changed order.
6. Balance payments towards the cost of the AGAPO Tour with the contact details of an emergency contact at home must reach us at least 45 days prior to the departure unless any other specific date is conveyed as last day for receiving the payment for your tour. If you fail to do so, this could result in cancellation of your seat on the tour and levy of Rs.5000/- (Rupees Five Thousand) as cancellation charges plus cost on actuals, if any, would be charged.
7. On payment of the balance amount in full you will receive your confirmation with final itinerary. This confirmation will be valid for your travel on the tour. Your Final documents will be issued, upon receiving your balance payment. It may be noted that the aforesaid payment does not include the cost of portorage, tips, insurance, laundry, phone calls, food and beverages or anything not specified in the itinerary of the tour. Your final AGAPO confirmation entitles you to travel on the Tour.
8. Cancellation Policy : If circumstances make you cancel your Tour, the cancellation must be intimated to us in writing. The cancellation charges would be levied will be as per actual and policy of each program.

9. AGAPO reserves the right to cancel any Tour prior to the departure, without assigning any reason. In such situation we will organize the Tour on a different date and make your bookings for the same if alternate Tour date is acceptable to you. Incase the alternate tour date is not acceptable to you, we will refund the entire amount due and payable to you, however, you will not be entitled to claim any compensation. AGAPO cannot take responsibility for any cost or any fees relating to the issuance and/ or cancellation of air tickets or other arrangements.

10. AGAPO would not be held responsible for occurrence of any of the following circumstances during or before the commencement of the Tour and any extra costs occurring due to these are to be borne by you:

- a) Any act of God, like heat wave, heavy rain, floods, land slide, earthquakes, extreme bad weather, war, Visa denied, deportation etc.
- b) Any delay or cancellation of flights, ferry, trains, bus etc.
- c) medical problem, sickness, physical inability to manage with the itinerary or any other such matter. Such an inability shall not affect/ delay rest of the group on the Tour.
- d) Lost luggage, loss of personal belongings and/ or theft etc.
- e) Change in foreign exchange rates after declaration of the tour price.

11. The Booking Conditions shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of India. Any litigation arising under or concerning these Booking Conditions shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the courts of Delhi.

12. Refunds (if any) for amendments and/ or cancellations will be paid directly to you by AGAPO . It would take at least 30 days to process refunds.

13. No refund for unused services and All the above tours are open for visit based on current updates. In case of closure for construction or any other reason, we will replace with a similar point of interest.

14. No early check in or late checkout is included, it's subject to availability.
