



Dr. Anthony Sciubba

Dr. Anthony Sciubba is a classical educator and school leader known for building strong academic communities, developing excellent teachers, and helping classical schools grow while remaining faithful to their mission.

Most recently, Dr. Sciubba served as Headmaster of Archway Classical Academy in Scottsdale, Arizona. During his tenure, he strengthened faculty culture and leadership, increasing teacher retention by 63 percent and raising faculty approval of school leadership by 15 percent, with faculty reporting 93 percent approval of his vision and leadership by example. He also helped reverse declining kindergarten enrollment and build strong demand and a waitlist for the school among local families.

Previously, Dr. Sciubba served as Academic Dean at Heritage Preparatory School of Georgia, where he helped launch the school's upper school and developed its classical Christian curriculum. Under his leadership, upper school enrollment grew by more than 150 percent, and the school's first graduating class achieved the highest average Classic Learning Test 10 (CLT-10) score in the United States.

Earlier in his career, Dr. Sciubba taught classics and humane letters at Chandler Preparatory Academy and served as an instructor at Pepperdine University and Emory University, teaching courses in history, theology, logic, and the humanities.

Dr. Sciubba believes deeply in the formative power of classical education and the role schools play in shaping both the minds and the character of young people. He and his family are excited to join the Telos Classical Academy community and look forward to partnering with faculty and families to continue building a school where students are formed in wisdom and virtue and prepared for lives of purpose and service.
